METROWEST DAY SCHOOL COLLABORATION

As part of the MetroWest Day School Campaign, new collaborative entities have developed. The following are descriptions and committee listings.

The MetroWest Day School Advisory of the JCF of MetroWest oversees the Community Fund, including grant-making, and plans long-term strategy for this fund and the campaign overall. Final grant approval comes from the JCF Board of Trustees. This Council is comprised of leading donors to the campaign, UJC and JCF leadership, and community representation. In addition, top lay and professionals from the three schools attend these meetings to provide vital input. Our schools owe a debt of gratitude to the lay leaders on this committee who devote significant time and energy to helping our schools improve.

The MetroWest Heads of School Council, comprised of top administrators from each school, meets every six weeks to plan collaborative programs and share ideas and strategies for improving the schools. This Council has so far established two collaborative sub-committees, one for **Marketing** and one for **Teacher Recruitment and Retention**.

All of this new collaboration requires ongoing professional staff. Through funding from the Day School Community Fund, MetroWest now has a part-time **Coordinator of Day School Endowment Projects**. Jordana works out of The Partnership for Jewish Learning and Life, a UJC MetroWest agency, and reports to the Heads of School Council.
